Itinerary

Day 1-We depart for the Golden Isles of Georgia. Our first stop will be in Brunswick, GA. Lunch on your own. We will be joined by a local guide for a tour of Brunswick. We travel to St. Simons Island and check into the Quality Inn Island House. Dinner on your own tonight.

Day 2— We start with a local guide for a tour of the historic area of Jekyll Island, including the Jekyll Island Club founded in 1886. We board a Tram for a tour of the Island with time to explore the island shops. We visit St. Simons with lunch on your own. Our guide will show us St. Simon Island including Christ Church, the St. Simons Lighthouse and Fort Frederica National Monument. Dinner will be at J Macs Restaurant. (DCB,D)

Day 3-We take a drive to historic Savannah, GA. Our first stop will be at the Savannah Visitor Center. You will receive a ticket for the Old Town Trolley, which gives you a narrated tour of Savannah with off and on stops at several key locations including River Street. You can shop and have lunch on your own on River Street. We pick you up at the Visitor Center and have an early dinner at the River House Restaurant before returning to New Brunswick. (DCB,D)

Day 4—We take a short ride to the Okefenokee Swamp Park “The Land of the Trembling Earth”. You have a boat tour and also visit the Serpentarium & Nature Center. We make a stop for lunch on your own and head home.
