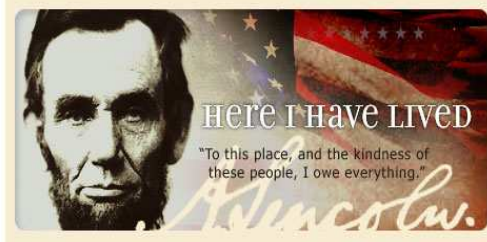

Itinerary**

Day 1—We depart for our trip to Chicago and the Land of Lincoln. Our first night's stay will be in Chattanooga, TN. We should arrive late afternoon. Dinner is included tonight. Comfort Inn (D)

Day 2—We continue Northwest to Collinsville, IL, located across the Mississippi River from St. Louis, MO . Tonight you can enjoy cocktails and limited dinner items at the Drury Inn. We will offer transportation to Lumiere Place Casino in downtown St. Louis. Drury Inn (DCB,LD)

Day 3—Today we visit the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial, better know as the Gateway Arch. We take a ride to the top for a view of St. Louis. You will be able to visit the Old Courthouse and more. Lunch will be on your own. This afternoon we tour the Anheuser-Busch Brewery and the Clydesdales. After our brewery tour, we head for Lincoln Land and Springfield, IL for the next two nights. Drury Inn (B,LD)

Day 4— We spend the next two days seeing the sights in Springfield, including the Lincoln Presidential Museum, the Lincoln Home National Historic Site, the Old State Capitol and Lincoln's Tomb. Dinner is included tonight. (B,D)

Day 5— We head for Amish Country in Arthur, IL where we have a guided tour of Amish Country. Lunch is included in a real Amish home. We continue on to Chicago arriving late afternoon. Dinner is on your own this evening. (B,L)

Day 6- We will be joined by a local guide for a city tour of Chicago. Lunch will be on your own. After lunch, we take a ride to the Skydeck at the Willis Tower (Sears Tower) It's on to the Navy Pier where you will have a little time on your own. We enjoy an architecture boat cruise on the Chicago River. Dinner is included tonight (B,D)

Day 7— We visit the Field Museum and "Sue", the famous T Rex Dinosaur. You will have time to see and shop the Magnificent Mile in on Michigan Av. We visit Eli's Cheesecake World, you will see Chicago's favorite desert being made. We return to our hotel later. Tonight we will have an entertaining dinner at Tommy Gun's Garage, a show set in a 1920's speakeasy. (B,D)

Day 8—We depart for Louisville, KY. We visit the Kentucky Derby Museum with a walking tour of Churchill Downs. We check into our hotel. Dinner is included tonight. Drury Inn (B,D)

Day 9 —We head for Abraham Lincoln's Birthplace National Historic Park. You will see the Memorial to Lincoln's birth. We will make a stop for lunch on your own, arriving in Marietta, GA late afternoon. Drury Inn (B,LD)

Day 10—Breakfast this morning and head for home. An early evening arrival is anticipated. (B)
