Niagara Falls & Ottawa September 24– October 4, 2012

Day 1—We begin our Niagara Falls & Ottawa trip today as we head North. We spend the night in Charlotte, NC. The Drury Inn serves Cocktails and limited dinner. Drury Inn (LD)

Day 2—We will continue to Hawks Nest State Park in West Virginia. Upon arrival we take the tram down to the New River to ride on a jetboat through the New River Gorge. We check into the Hawks Nest Lodge to spend the night. Dinner will be included at the lodge. Hawks Nest Lodge (B,D)

Day 3— We continue North today with our first stop at Fort Necessity National Battlefield, site of first battle of the French & Indian War and George Washington's first battle. We visit the "New" Flight 93 National Memorial. We will go to the Pittsburgh area to spend the night. Dinner is on your own tonight. Comfort Suites (DCB)

Day 4—We travel to Niagara Falls arriving around noon time. After crossing the border, we go to the Falls overlook with time for lunch on your own. After lunch, you are free to enjoy Niagara as you wish including time to take a ride on the famous Maid of Mist for those with a little adventure. We check into the Hampton Inn North of the Falls. Dinner is on your own tonight. Hampton Inn North of the Falls (2nts) (DCB,D)

Day 5—We are joined by a local guide for a busy day. We begin on the Niagara Falls Parkway with a stop at the Floral Clock, the Aero Car Whirlpool and a trip to the picturesque village of Niagara on the Lake. You will have time for lunch on your own and browsing. We stop at a winery on the way back to our hotel. Tonight we have dinner at the Minolta Tower. (DCB,D)

Day 6— We cross back into the US as we head for Ottawa, the National Capital of Canada. We stop in Seneca Falls, NY for a visit to the Women's Rights National Historical Park. You will have time for lunch on your own in the village. We continue to Ottawa where we should arrive at our downtown hotel late afternoon. You are free to enjoy your evening in Ottawa as you wish. Best Western Plus Victoria Park Suites. (DCB)

Day 7—We are joined by a costumed guide for a city tour of Ottawa, driving by the Prime Minister's Residence, Rideau Hall, Rideau Canal, the Rockcliffe district and a tour of the Parliament Building. Lunch will be on your own at the famous Byward Market. Dinner is included at Canal Ritz restaurant. (DCB,D)

Day 8— We cross back into the US as we travel to Alexandria Bay, NY near the 1000 Islands. We enjoy a 2 1/2 hour luncheon cruise on Uncle Sam Boat Tours on the St Lawrence River and a visit to Boldt Castle. We travel to Courtland, NY to spend the night. Dinner is on your own tonight. Country Inn (DCB,L)

9— We head to Baltimore, MD. We visit Ft McHenry National Monument, home of the Star Spangled Banner. We continue to Alexandria, VA to spend the night. We visit Historic Alexandria for dinner on your own. Country Inn (DCB)

Day 10—We travel to Santee, SC to spend the last night of our tour. Hampton Inn, We have dinner at Clark's Restaurant. (DCB,D)
