***Itinerary***

Day 1—We depart today for the Blue Ridge Parkway. We spend the night in Lumberton, SC. Dinner is included tonight. Fairfield Inn. ( D)

Day 2—We continue on North to the home of Thomas Jefferson’s Monticello. We arrive in the afternoon to visit the home and grounds. We spend the night in Charlottestown, VA. Dinner will be on your own tonight. (DCB)

Day 3—This morning take a short ride to the Northern entrance to the Blue Ridge Parkway to begin our scenic drive down the parkway. We make several stops today along the parkway. We also make a stop off the parkway at Natural Bridge and Caverns. We end our day in Roanoke, VA. Comfort Inn (DCB,D)

Day 4—We return to the parkway this morning and continue South on the parkway, making several stops along the way including Mabry Mill and the Northwest Trading Post. We spend the next two nights in Boone, NC. Dinner is on your own tonight. Country Inn (2nts)(DCB)

Day 5—We spend most of the day in the Boone area today with a few stops on the Parkway. Our first stop will be Grandfather Mountain with its “mile high” suspension bridge. We will stop at the Moses Cone Parkway Craft Center. Afterwards we continue to the village of Blowing Rock for lunch and shopping on your own. This afternoon we visit the Blowing Rock and a stop at the original Mast General Store near Boone. Dinner is included tonight. (DCB,D)

Day 6—It’s back to the Parkway this morning today we make several stops including Lin Cove Viaduct, Linville Falls and Mt Mithcell State Park, the highest point East of the Mississippi River. We end our day in Ashville, NC to spend the next two nights. Country Inn Dinner is included tonight. (2 nts) (DCB,D)

Day 7—We visit Biltmore Estate this morning. Here you will be able to tour the Home and winery and have lunch on your own while here. This afternoon we will have a guided tour of Asheville including a stop at the historic Grove Park Inn. Dinner is included tonight. (DCB,D)

Day 8—We leave Asheville this morning and travel to Gold City Gem Mine in Franklin, NC, where you will get the chance to mine for gold and other gems. Later we continue to the famous Dillard House for a family style lunch. After lunch we make a stop at Toccoa Falls College for a visit to scenic Toccoa Falls. We continue on to the Drury Inn south of Atlanta to spend the night. The Drury Inn serves complimentary cocktails and limited dinner item this evening. (DCB, L, LD)
