Itinerary**

Day 1—We head to Washington DC for our Christmas Holiday. We spend the night in Lumberton, NC. Fairfield Inn Dinner is included to-night. (D)

Day 2—We continue North for a visit to George Washington's home for a Mount Vernon Christmas. On arrival lunch, is on your own and you will see Mount Vernon at Christmas. We continue to Camp Springs, MD near Washington, DC and Alexandria, VA to spend the next four nights. This evening we will visit historic Alexandria for dinner on your own,(4 nts) (DCB)

Day 3—We are off to Washington, where you will have a ticket for the Tourmobile (\*see note below), the Tourmobile will transport you to all of the major sites in Washington including, but not limited to Arlington Cemetery and the tomb of the Unknown Soldier and Lee Mansion. They also make stops at all major monuments and memorials, the National Archives, Smithsonian Museums and Union Station. Tonight we have dinner at Pier 7 Restaurant on the Potomac and see the National Christmas Tree and more. (DCB,D)

Day 4— We will tour the US Capitol. The rest of the day is free to do as you wish including exploring the Smithsonian Museums. We return to the hotel late afternoon. Tonight we visit the National Harbor on the Potomac for browsing and dinner on your own and of course Christmas lights. (DCB)

Day 5—This morning we are off to the "new" National Air and Space Museum near Dulles airport. We drive back to Washington for time on your own. This afternoon we tour the Washington National Cathedral. Tonight we have dinner at America Restaurant in Union Station and make another drive around to see the Christmas Lights. (DCB,D)

Day 6—We will travel back south to Santee, SC where we will check into our hotel. Tonight we have dinner at Clarks Restaurant. Hampton Inn (DCB,D)

Day 7—We travel home with memories of our Christmas in Washington Trip. A stop for lunch (on your own) and an early evening arrival is anticipated. (DCB)
